1.0 General Rules

1.1 Driver's must be 18 yrs. of age or older to participate.

a) There will be exceptions made if we feel the need to.

1.2 Everyone must be on DISCORD to participate.

1.3 Drivers must have a stable internet connection. DIRT Series is not responsible for drivers who are not able to sustain a connection to the server.

a) Drivers must maintain a reasonable ping. Drivers unable to maintain a reasonable ping will be removed from the server.

1.4 Zero tolerance for cheating. If caught cheating in any form you will be banned from all DIRT Series events permanently.

1.5 Anything that could be considered unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated.

a) This includes, but is not limited to, inappropriate comments during a race or after. This also includes social media networks, and will be left up to the discretion of any admin.

1.6 Inappropriate language will be issued one warning, after that you will be disqualified, with no points being awarded.

1.7 Arguing with any DIRT Series Admin will result in an automatic disqualification, and/or suspensions/penalties. This will be left up to the Admins discretion.

1.8 Missing the Drivers' Meeting will result in you being moved to the End Of The Longest line at the start of your Heat Race.

1.9 Numbers will be first come when you enter the race server.

2.0 Racing Rules

2.1 Drivers must stay at a pace during all starts and restarts, until an admin starts the race. If caught jumping the start you will be moved to the rear at the next caution or at the conclusion of the race. Initial Start is on GREEN Light. Restarts are on the leader once he advances to the center of turn 3 & 4.

2.2 Drivers must stay single file until you pass the start/finish line on the ALL starts; your front bumper to their rear bumper.

a) Penalties as follows:

1st offense – Penalized 1 lap at the conclusion of the race.

2nd offense – Penalized 1 lap at the conclusion of the race; and suspended for 1 week.

3rd offense – Disqualified from the race; suspended for 2 weeks.

2.3 Drivers may only have a maximum of one car length between them and the car in front of them on starts and restarts, if this becomes a problem you will be moved to the end of line.

2.4 Drivers spinning 3 times, or involved in 3 cautions, must exit immediately. If you do not exit, you will be disqualified for that event. If it happens a second time during a series, you will be suspended for 2 weeks.

2.5 When the caution is waved slow down and get in a single file line behind whomever iRacing is telling you to line up behind.

a) Once iRacing makes the call on where you are to go that call is final.

2.6 Rough driving complaints, should be replay reviewed and taken up with an admin within 15 minutes after race.

2.7 Any race admin can ask you to exit server at any time during the race, for any reason they feel deserves this action.

2.8 If you make the A-Main and leave the server without contacting a DIRT Series Admin with a legitimate reason; then you will be suspended for the following week.

3.0 Racing Procedures

3.1 (18x) Incident Points will be used in the A-Main. When you reach the 18x you will be removed from the race by iRacing.

3.2 You will be allowed 3 quick repairs in the A-Main.

3.3 No quick repairs will be allowed in the Heat Races.

3.4 If you go a lap down while pitting, we will not get that lap back via a wave around.

4.0 Post-Race Inspection

4.1 If someone has an issue with a competitor and would like to file a complaint with one of our Admins then move to the Admin Waiting Room channel in DISCORD and one of our Admins will come a chat with you.
